When you leave a body of water:

- ✓ Drain your motor, bilge and any other areas that hold water and let equipment dry completely.
- ✓ Remove ALL plants and animals from boat and trailer and dispose of in garbage container.
- ✓ Whenever possible, wash your boat with fresh water or spray with pure vinegar after every use.
- ✓ Follow a regular hull inspection and cleaning routine.
- ✓ Use an anti-fouling preparation on your hull, outboards, rudders and other surfaces below the water line.
